Command Line MySQL

Here are a few useful MySQL commands you can run from the command line, handy if you have installed MySQL and you don't have desktop access or a graphical MySQL manager application.

Login to MySQL First we must login *mysql -u root -p* — (the *root* part assumes *root* is your mysql username)

Create a MySQL Database **CREATE DATABASE new_database;** — (don't forget the **semicolon ;** it's really important)

Show a MySQL Database **SHOW DATABASES;**
