

# Console Commands

**Note: At the time of writing (Oct2016) any upgrade to the MFEL will wipe any custom Console commands**

When configuring the MFEL (Muse Live) there are some options that can not be set from the web interface, for these extra settings we can use the Console.

Enter the following address in to the web browser

```
http://<ip address>/Console
```

To login, use the following credentials:

```
admin  
envivio
```

```
