

# Configure Static IP Address

Raspbian Jesse changed the way a static IP Address is configured. The static IP settings are now held in a file located in the **/etc** directory called **dhcpcd.conf**

To edit the dhcpcd.conf file, enter:

**sudo /etc/dhcpcd.conf**

At the end of the file add the following lines (with your own IP Address values)

```
eth0
    static ip_address=192.168.1.14/24
    static routers=192.168.1.1
    static domain_name_servers=192.168.1.4
```

Save the file.

To enable the changes you can either restart the network service:

```
/etc/init.d/networking restart
```

Or you can simply reboot:

```
sudo reboot
```
