Configure Static IP Address

Raspbian Jesse changed the way a static IP Address is configured. The static IP settings are now held in a file located in the /*etc* directory called *dhcpcd.conf*

To edit the dhcpcd.conf file, enter: **sudo** /**etc/dhcpcd.conf**

At the end of the file add the following lines (with your own IP Address values)

```
eth0
static ip_address=192.168.1.14/24
static routers=192.168.1.1
static domain_name_servers=192.168.1.4
```

Save the file.

To enable the changes you can either restart the network service:

/etc/init.d/networking restart

Or you can simply reboot:

sudo reboot
