

wget Examples

wget can be used to get a single file from a website, or to download the entire site if you know how. Here some examples of using wget.

Download a single file

To get a single file from a website, and save it using it's default name, use:

```
wget http://www.cameraangle.co.uk/index.php  
This will download the file index.php from www.cameraangle.co.uk
```

Download a single file and rename it

To get a single file from a website, and save it using a new name, use:

```
wget http://www.cameraangle.co.uk/index.php -O index.txt  
This will download the file index.php from www.cameraangle.co.uk and save it as index.txt
```

Resume an interrupted download previously started by wget itself

This does depend on the site supporting resuming.

```
wget --continue example.com/big.file.iso
```

Download a file but only if the version on server is newer than your local copy

```
wget --continue --timestamping wordpress.org/latest.zip
```

Download a web page with all assets

Download a web page with all assets – like stylesheets and inline images – that are required to properly display the web page offline.

```
wget --page-requisites --span-hosts --convert-links --adjust-extension http://example.com/dir/file
```
