

# Add a user to Sudoers group

Sometimes typing Sudo and entering a password gets a bit laborious, and if you are the only user on a system then why bother? For this reason we can add a user to the **Sudoers** group, giving them 'root' access without having to endlessly enter their password.

You need to already have an account in the sudoers group for this to work (root user normally)

```
usermod -aG sudo username
```
