

# Check Running Encoder Processes

Sometimes its handy to see what processes are running and using resources. Encoding processes use the most resources. Use this command to check the running encoding processes:

```
ps -A |grep encoding
```

This will give an output similar to the following:

```
35949 ?      01:14:59 encodingProcess
35964 ?      01:08:02 encodingProcess
(The PID numbers will differ)
```

If you stop the envivio-muse service and run `ps -A |grep encoding`. If you still see running services, kill them as they are stuck.
